# 57,322 TOTAL INDIVIDUALS SERVED

# FEEDING MILITARY FAMILIES IN NEED

Last year we served 4,279 individuals through our newest initiative, the Pendleton Pantry. This food pantry allows us to increase the amount of food, supplies, and overall support we are able to provide for military families in need.

# SPREADING JOY DURING THE HOLIDAYS

Our Santa's Workshop event is an initiative that brings joy to hundreds of military families during the holiday season. This three-day event embodied the spirit of giving by providing a space where families selected donated gifts for their children, along with commissary gift cards, holiday food, stocking stuffers, and more! We also coordinated a Home Hospitality program where local community members were matched with Marines and hosted them on Thanksgiving day. In total, we served 4,045 individuals through these Holiday initiatives.



# DEVELOPING SKILLS FOR KINDERGARTEN SUCCESS AND SUPPORTING SPOUSES

Operation Little Learners is a parent and child class for children 18 months - 5 years old that provides a setting for both parents and children to make new friendships and feel part of a community, while also having fun and learning new skills.

Now in its 28th year, the latest Operation Little Learners cohort served 2,874 parents/children. Parents and kids alike experienced a year full of fun, learning, and exploration!





# PROVIDING REST AND RELAXATION AT THE SOI RECREATION CENTER

Throughout 2023, we had 13,233 check-ins from SOI Marines. We held BBQs, Super Bowl parties, and Holiday events. We also installed new flooring and purchased new recliners and gaming computers!

# ADDRESSING CHILD CARE NEEDS OF MILITARY FAMILIES

The Armed Services YMCA Fisher Children's Center is an hourly, part-day, and full-day childcare center for active-duty military families stationed at Camp Pendleton. Last year, we provided more than 50,000 hours of quality and affordable childcare.

Additionally, thanks to the financial support from incredible donors, we have extended financial aid to families awaiting placement in order to help combat the cost of childcare off base.


